Communication & Language in Early Years

In this course you will gain an understanding of how to support your children with communication and language including playing, speaking, storytelling, singing, phonics and early writing skills.

Mathematics in Early Years

In this course you will gain an understanding of how to support your children with Math's including counting, shapes, space, measures, weights and positional language.

Caring for Children:

This course will include learning about child care and age appropriate activities to help support learning and play. You will learn about how to make the best of community activities. You will also get practical health and safety tips to ensure play is fun and safe. This will be an accredited City and Guilds Course.

English Conversation:

This course includes: gaining confidence in communication with others e.g. GP's, Dentist, Health Visitors and other professionals, understanding the meaning of words commonly used by others, as well as gaining confidence to ask for support when needed.

Employability:

This course will include: CV writing, interview skills (including what to expect and role play exercises), application form support, dress codes, questions to ask when at interviews, job search techniques, gaining confidence in yourself as well as receiving information about other courses relevant to your own career paths.

A Crèche will be provided for these courses; however spaces are limited please call and book in advance. Please note: Crèche spaces are only available for children ages 0-5years old and are £3 per child per week. Snack will be provided for the children.
