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Activity: Metal detectors - Hide metal / plastic objects in sand and encourage the children to explore and find the object.

Ask the children:

- ✓ Encourage to explore the metal detectors - use buttons.
- ✓ Talk to the children about the different media, and explain what makes the detector bleeps.
- ✓ How else can we use the detectors? Explore the environment
- ✓ Let the children explore at their own pace
- ✓ Use words such as *metal, plastic, wood, wool, bleep, ect*
