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Activity: Washing Babies

Explain to the parents

- ✓ Today we are helping your child to be aware of their body parts.
- ✓ Use lots of describing words, the more different words children hear the larger the vocab they will have, introduce body parts such as neck, chest, thighs, shins (if appropriate)
- ✓ Let your child play and talk to them about what they are doing and why it is important to be clean and healthy
- ✓ Always follow your child's lead.
- ✓ Be positive and proud of your child's achievement.

<p>EYFS Main Learning Outcome: 22-50 months: Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys. 22-36 months - interested in others play and beginning to join in</p>	<p>Key Characteristic of Learning focus: <i>(playing & exploring, active learning, creating & thinking critically)</i></p> <p>Using senses to explore the world around them playing and exploring. Pretending objects are things from their experience.</p>
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<p>Resources: Water tray, dolls, flannels, towels and bubbles</p>	<p>Safety Issues: Parents to supervise children, slipping on water</p>
