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Activity: Exploring sand and the consistency needed to build sand castle

Explain to the parents:

- ✓ Today we are given your child a chance to explore the sand. Let your child choose to play and mix the dry to wet sand.
- ✓ Talk to your child about how the sand feels, is it wet / dry
- ✓ Ask them what they think is happening, when they mix the sand? What can they make when the sand is wet
- ✓ When the sand is wet / dry how does it feel
- ✓ Let the children explore at their own pace
