EYFS Main Learning Outcome:

16-26 months - shows interest in toys with buttons, flaps and simple mechanisms, and beginning how to operate them.

22-36 months - seeks to acquire basic skills in turning on and operating some equipment

Try these at home:

Cause and Effect toys - Cause and effect toys teach children just that: when I do an action, I get a result and different actions have different results. It's an important concept to work on because it is so essential for a lot of other cognitive, social, and communication skills. Some basic cause and effect toys are: Pop up toys.
