Playful learning:

EYFS Main Learning Outcome:

22-50 months: Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys.
22-36 months - interested in others play and beginning to join in

Try these at home:

Role Play ~ Now the weather is getting better you can spend extra time in the garden, acting out popular children's stories such as ~ We're going on a bear hunt, Three little pigs, Goldilocks and the three bears.

Mask making ~ Make masks to use during your role play, encourage the whole family to join in so your child gets use to playing with others and sharing.

Teddy bears picnic ~ Place a blanket on the floor and make a picnic, encourage your child to invite their teddies along and all serve each other pretend food. Remember to sing the song 😊
