EYFS Main Learning Outcome:

22-50 months: Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys.
22-36 months - interested in others play and beginning to join in

Try these at home:

Story Time ~ The Gruffalo ~ The story of The Gruffalo is a wonderful children's story which allows them to experiment with lots of different sound and you can help them to stretch their imagination by asking questions - How do you think the snake moves? What sound would the owl make, Can you sniff like a fox?

Visit the local Park ~ Go and find the Gruffalo and his friends in the park, Encouraging your child to creep slowly and quietly, make your stop and listen to see if they can hear the Gruffalo and his friends. The more interesting you make your visit the more your child will join in
